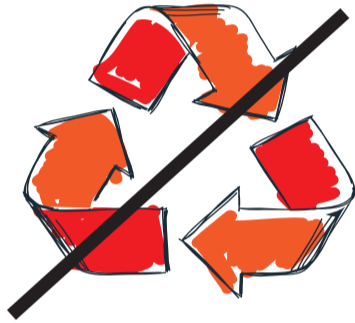








# WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT RECYCLING

YOU CAN **NO LONGER** PUT THE FOLLOWING AS RECYCLABLES IN YOUR KERBSIDE CRATES, AT THE RURAL RECYCLING STATIONS OR AT THE RESOURCE RECOVERY CENTRE

- SOFT PLASTICS
- HARD PLASTICS

**ABOVE - THESE ITEMS ARE TO BE PUT IN YOUR GENERAL WASTE**

There will be additional changes to the layout at the resource recovery centre, that will ask you split out items into separate cages.

**BELOW - THESE ARE THE ITEMS THAT *CAN BE PUT INTO YOUR KERBSIDE CRATES AND AT RURAL RECYCLING STATIONS***

Please remember to **wash and squash** all items

**Reason for the change:** *The worlds recyclable markets have diminished significantly. There are no longer viable markets for most used plastics and paper.
